Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin. · Danger: May cause sensitisation by inhalation and skin contact. Severe allergic skin reaction, bronchial spasms and anaphylactic shock are possible. Medical supervision for at least 48 hours. If necessary oxygen respiration treatment.
