DESCRIPTION: Acarus siro extract

Storage mites such as *Acarus siro* are commonly found in stored foods such as grain, flour, and hay (1). They are known to cause symptoms such as bronchial asthma, allergic rhinitis, and conjunctivitis, particularly in rural work environments. These mites thrive in warm, humid

conditions (2).

NOTE: AS extract has a unique composition depending on the raw mite materials. The reactivity

of this product may differ from batch to batch.

APPLICATION: ELISA, Western Blot, Immunization

QUANTITY: 0.6 mg protein (Bradford Assay)

FORM: Lyophilized powder

SOLUBILITY: Dissolve in distilled water, phosphate buffered saline pH 7.4, or an equivalent buffer

STORAGE: -20°C

STABILITY: 2 years
